

# DIRECTIONS FOR PARKING & UNLOADING

(MAP AND DIRECTIONS TO PLU ON THE BACK)

Lagerquist Concert Hall, Mary Baker Russell Music Center, Building 19

- **ARRIVAL WITH EQUIPMENT AND/OR INSTRUMENTS:** unload from bus(es) at the corner of 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue South and Wheeler Street South (**Point A**). This is the stage entrance for Lagerquist Concert Hall and the Mary Baker Russell Music Center (MBRMC). **Please unload as quickly as possible to avoid traffic congestion on Wheeler Street. PLEASE NOTE: have all other students stay on the bus until it is parked on lower campus.** Once the bus has been unloaded, have the driver park the bus in the lower campus MBR parking lot (**Point B**) (see directions to lower parking lot below).
- **ARRIVAL WITH NO EQUIPMENT OR INSTRUMENTS:** go directly to **Point B** (see directions to lower parking lot below). Drop off your students and park the bus in this parking area until the end of your visit (students should be dropped off and picked up at same location).
- Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before your scheduled check-in time. Classes are in session and we apologize that we do not have space to accommodate your group before your visit. If you would like to schedule a campus tour either before or after your visit, please contact PLU Admissions (Point E) at (253) 535-7151 or go to [www.plu.edu/visit](http://www.plu.edu/visit).
- **DEPARTURE:** Instruct all students to arrive promptly at **Point B** after the Lagerquist Concert Hall visit. If you have equipment/instruments to load, drive to **Point A** once your students have returned to the bus. Please load equipment as quickly as possible, and check that all students and their personal items are accounted for before departing PLU.
- **PLEASE INFORM YOUR STUDENTS** that PLU is not responsible for any lost or stolen items while visiting campus, and that PLU's concert hall policy is **no food or drink permitted in the concert hall**.

**DIRECTIONS TO LOWER PARKING LOT:** Drive west on Wheeler Street to the bottom of the hill and make a left. Take your next left and continue around corner until you see the Pacific Lutheran University sign. Pull the bus into this parking lot and park bus. You will see the brick MBR music building to the east. If you enter the building from this level (1<sup>st</sup> floor), you will proceed to the third floor via steps or elevator. Please have one designated stop in at the music office (2<sup>nd</sup> floor, room 206) and check-in.

## SELECTED BUILDINGS OF INTEREST TO YOUR GROUP:

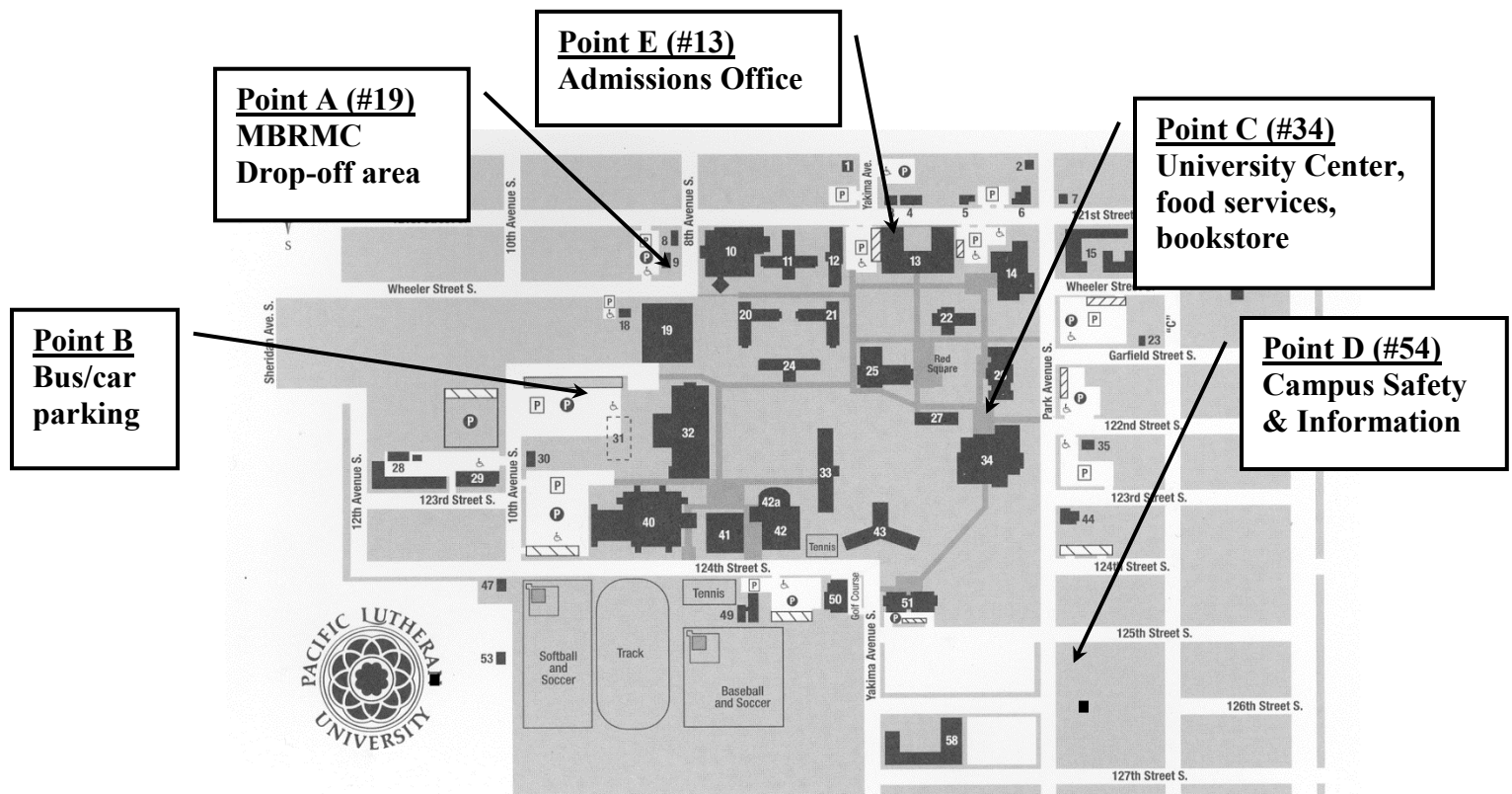
**Point A** indicates the Mary Baker Russell Music Center (unloading area), (253) 535-7602.

## MAP AND DIRECTIONS TO PLU and Mary Baker Russell Music Center

- Pacific Lutheran University is located seven miles south of downtown Tacoma, Washington.
- Take exit 127 off of Interstate 5 and head east on Highway 512.
- Continue on 512 for approximately two miles to Pacific Avenue (Parkland-Spanaway exit).
- Take the WA-7/Pacific Ave exit toward Parkland/Spanaway
- Turn right (south) on Pacific Avenue to 121<sup>st</sup> Street.
- Turn right on 121<sup>st</sup> Street.
- Continue on 121<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue South and Wheeler. Parking is limited in the Wheeler Parking Lot as classes are in session. Other parking is available on the street or on lower campus.

**DIRECTIONS TO LOWER CAMPUS PARKING LOT:** Drive west on Wheeler Street downhill and take your first left on South Sheridan Avenue, go one block. Take your next immediate left on Garfield Street South and continue around the corner until you see the Pacific Lutheran University sign (you will be on 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue South). Pull into this lot and park. You will see the brick MBR music building on the hill. Enter the building from this level (first floor) and proceed to the third floor concert hall. We are handicap accessible and have an elevator on each floor.
